

Crete Resolution

The ESWTR, in accord with its founding maxims, pledges to continue pursuing its interreligious trajectory. The specific steps to achieving this end are:

- 1. putting on national and international conferences that take account of the religious plurality within Europe;
- 2. ensuring that this plurality is represented on the ESWTR's website;
- 3. committing to personally approach female theologians of various religions and to invite them to join the ESWTR;
- 4. ensuring that this religious plurality is represented in the ESWTR's decision-making groups.

Practical agenda:

In order to implement this resolution, we endorse the installation of a policymaking group. In particular, the following existing networks will be employed in order to establish contact with potentially interested women:

AAR (American Academy of Religion), EPIL (European Project for Interreligious Learning), IKETH (Interreligious Conference of European Theologians), WCC (World Council of Churches, especially its "Programme for Women in Church and Society"), IARG (Int. Association for the Study of

Religion and Gender), LWF (Lutheran World Federation, especially its network "Women in Church and Society") and CEC (Conference of European Churches).
